KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2000-071

A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LAND LOCATED IN THE COOPER LANDING AREA LYING WITHIN A PORTION THE SW1/4NW1/4, SECTION 27, T5N, R3W, S.M., ALASKA, CONTAINING 60,000.00 SQUARE FEET MORE OR LESS WITH AN OVERLAY CLASSIFICATION OF RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

- **WHEREAS,** the borough has received Final Decision, State ADL No. 201307, for the subject parcel; and
- WHEREAS, the underlying land is classified Residential per Resolution 97-060; and
- WHEREAS, the subject parcel is proposed for slope beautification to restore the site to a safe and stable condition that will be suitable for revegetation; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed slope beautification project will require an overlay classification of Resource Management; and
- **WHEREAS,** pursuant to KPB Chapter 17.10.080 public notice was published and notification was sent to land owners and/or leaseholders of record within a one-half mile radius of the land proposed for classification, and to applicable agencies and other interested groups; and
- WHEREAS, the Cooper Landing Advisory Planning Commission held a special public meeting on the proposed classification July 5, 2000. A motion was passed to recommend postponing the proposed overlay classification of Resource Management; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed classification during its regularly scheduled July 24, 2000 meeting and unanimously recommended approval of the proposed classification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That portion of Borough land, as shown on Attachment A which is incorporated herein by reference, located within the SW1/4NW1/4, Section 27, T5N, R3W, S.M., Alaska, containing 60,000.00 square feet be classified with an overlay classification of Resource Management.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Resource Management classification overlay be removed at the conclusion of the project.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
