**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE'S COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM IN COOPERATION WITH THE NIKISKI  
SENIOR CITIZENS, INC.**


- WHEREAS,** notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development that grant funding is available for the 2000 federal fiscal year through its Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"); and
- WHEREAS,** eligible applicants include any municipal government entity defined by Title 29, except the Municipality of Anchorage; and
- WHEREAS,** an eligible applicant may submit a CDBG application in cooperation with a non-municipal entity such as a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20 and which is in good standing with the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS,** the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., is a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20 and is in good standing with the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS,** the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., has requested that the Borough submit an application in cooperation with them for a grant in an amount up to \$200,000 from DCED under their CDBG program to expand and improve their senior center facility; and
- WHEREAS,** a project to expand and improve a senior center meets the preliminary eligibility criteria as a limited clientele activity under the CDBG program's community development category;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate, execute, and submit to the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development any and all documents required for a cooperative application on behalf of the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., for a grant up to \$200,000 under the CDBG program for expansion and improvements to the Nikiski Senior Center.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
