WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur reduces the potential for harm to people and property and saves taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna participated jointly in the planning process with the Kenai Peninsula Borough to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on June 2, 2004 on the proposed mitigation plan;

WHEREAS, the Soldotna Planning and Zoning Commission comments have been incorporated into this All Hazard Mitigation Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA, ALASKA:

Section 1. The City of Soldotna Hazard Mitigation Plan is adopted.


