C.A.N. – The Community Alert Network is a state-of-the-art telecommunications service designed to inform you and your neighbors of critical situations at a moment's notice. In the event of an emergency you will receive a telephone call informing you of the situation and advising you of what to do.

Siren – Sirens may be sounded by the Kenai Peninsula Borough, the Alaska State Troopers in Soldotna, or sounded locally. **Turn on your Radio or TV** and listen for official information.
