Sir- I am writing to comment on KPB16516230, Cecil R. Jones permit to remove gravel at approx. mile 2 on the North Fork Rd., Anchor Pt., Ak. I am an adjoining property owner at Eva Fay Sub. lot 12. I have 2 wells on the property with patent water rights. My wells are approximately 20 feet deep and will be disturbed by the proposed pit which may be 40 feet or more deep. Ground water is at about 10 feet deep as the well log Jones submitted shows- not the 16 feet he states. There are about 40 homes within 1/2 mile of the pit and all will be adversely affected by the dust and noise created. Approximately 9.5 acres of the site is wetlands and birds and other wildlife will be displaced with the loss of habitat. This is a residential area and not a commercial enterprise area. Our way of life and property values will be adversely affected by the proposed pit. I am strongly opposed to the issuance of the proposed permit. Sincerely , Richard L.
