

# HOW TO RECYCLE . . .

<b>ALUMINUM CANS</b>	Empty beverage cans only. Accepted at all facilities.	<b>No</b> other aluminum products or tin.
<b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b>	Flatten and place in container. Corrugated cardboard has wavy-type layer in between. Accepted at all facilities.	<b>No</b> waxed cardboard or paperboard (cereal or beverage container material).
<b>GLASS</b>	Clean container glass only. Accepted at all facilities.	Remove lids; leave labels. No lights, mirrors or other glass.
<b>HAZARDOUS WASTE</b>	Accepted only on designated collection days (see other side) at Central Peninsula Landfill, Homer Baling Facility and Seward Transfer Facility.	<u>On collection days</u> , deliver hazardous waste such as paint, solvent, cleaner, pesticides, etc. to the collection facility.
<b>HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES</b>	AA, 12 volt, etc. Accepted at Central Peninsula Landfill, Homer Baling Facility, and Transfer Facilities in Kenai, Nikiski, Seward and Sterling.	Ask attendant to direct you to collection container.
<b>MIXED PAPER</b>	Copy, notebook, greenbar computer, envelopes (with/without windows), magazines, catalogs, paperboard (cereal and beverage boxes) fax paper, carbonless paper, manila & bleached file folders, astrobright & goldenrod colored paper, glossy and construction paper, shredded paper, post-it notes and phone books. Accepted at all facilities.	Remove paper clips and clasp holders. Staples OK.
<b>NEWSPAPER</b>	Place loose in container. Accepted at all facilities.	Make sure paper is clean and dry. Newspapers and inserts <u>Only</u> please.
<b>PLASTIC - PETE#1 &amp; HDPE#2</b>	Clean plastic containers. Accepted at Central Peninsula Landfill, Homer Baling Facility and Seward Transfer Facility.	No chemical containers or plastic tubs.
<b>PLASTIC BAGS</b>	Accepted at Central Peninsula Landfill only.	Clean plastic grocery or trash bags accepted.
<b>TIN CANS</b>	Clean tin cans only. Accepted at Central Peninsula Landfill only.	Labels may be left on.
<b>USED OIL</b>	10 gallons at a time - maximum 25 gallons per month. Accepted during operating hours at the Central Peninsula Landfill, Homer Baling Facility, and Transfer Facilities in Kenai, Nikiski, Seward and Sterling.	Oil only. Can not have water, antifreeze, etc. included. Sign-in with attendant and they will direct you to the tank.
<b>VEHICLE LEAD-ACID BATTERIES</b>	No more than 10 per year. Accepted during operating hours at the Central Peninsula Landfill, Homer Baling Facility, and Transfer Facilities in Kenai, Nikiski, Seward and Sterling.	Please ask facility attendant to direct you to battery totes.
<b>VEHICLES</b>	Special preparation required. Accepted at Central Peninsula Landfill and Homer Landfill.	Contact landfill for special preparation instructions and forms.
